Z Z WARRIOR chased between horses or off the rail, bid between foes nearing the quarter pole to take the lead, inched away under urging in the stretch and won clear. DELAHOOSSEE bumped at the start, pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, was in a bit tight into the turn, split horses leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and just got the place. APRIORITY stalked three deep then outside the winner, bid three wide leaving the turn, drifted in some in the stretch and was edged late for second. GREENSPAN bumped at the start, went up inside a rival to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, relinquished command nearing the quarter pole, came out in the stretch and weakened. DONATO steadied in tight off heels early, chased a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. FITZ THE CAT chased outside, went three deep into and out of the turn and did not rally. JAMES M. DEAN had early speed outside a rival then stalked off the rail, dropped back between horses leaving the backstretch and gave way.
