M. A. FOX settled off the rail, moved up on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied to the lead under urging a sixteenth out and held on gamely. MEA DOMINA chased off the inside, also moved up on the turn and came out three deep into the stretch, bid between foes past the eighth pole, fought back inside the winner to the wire. ETCH sped to the early lead outside, angled in on the backstretch, set the pace inside, could not match the top pair late but bested the rest. ALCHEMA chased outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and did not rally. MINNIE THE MOOCHER stalked off the rail then outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. NORTH UPPER STREET had good early speed and stalked the pace inside but also weakened in the drive. THAT LOOK settled outside, angled in leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. LOVER COME BACK settled a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and did not rally. DAYTIME EVENT tracked the leader three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. KLASSY KATLYN between horses early, chased inside, drifted out in the stretch while being eased in the final furlong.
