Footnotes

CHAW FIRE chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied to the lead under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. SALAH'S JEWELS had speed between horses then dueled inside, inched away into the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. ISABELLA'S CROWN chased outside, went three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. ABSTRACT FACT saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. WEAREHAVING FUNYET had speed three deep then dueled outside the runner-up, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. HOT 'N LACEY chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. WARREN'S WALK off a bit slowly, settled inside, came out from the rail leaving the backstretch, angled out into the stretch and was not a threat. QUIET ADVICE also broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside and was always outrun.
