**Footnotes**

RAIL TRIP stalked outside a rival or between foes, bid alongside the runner-up on the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch, kicked clear under urging and proved best under steady handling late. TRES BORRACHOS sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner thereafter but was clearly second best. LIFE IS SWEET unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, found the fence on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the show outside foes late. MAST TRACK saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. PARADING chased between horses then outside, continued three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. INFORMED four wide into the first turn, chased outside rivals, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and also lacked the needed late kick. MAGNUM (ARG) close up stalking the pace three deep, continued outside on the backstretch, was between horses leaving the second turn and weakened. GLOBAL HUNTER (ARG) four wide into the first turn, settled outside then off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. DAKOTA PHONE allowed to settle between horses chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. BULLSBAY pulled a bit early, chased just off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and lacked a response in the stretch. SONG OF NAVARONE pulled his way between horses then chased between foes or a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and had no rally. BIG BOOSTER broke slowly and was squeezed a bit, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a factor. AUTISM AWARENESS broke out a bit, stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, went between foes on the second turn and again nearing the stretch, then weakened.
