ALYAXY three deep into and on the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the leader on the second turn and dueled outside that one through a stiff drive, put a head in front in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. DINNERATHEPALMS sped to the early lead and set the pace along the inside, dueled inside the winner on the second turn and through a long, hard drive and continued gamely to the wire. AIRIASAFFAIR five wide into the first turn and forced out a bit by the spill, stalked outside on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn and had little left for the drive. HEYERDAHL saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the backstretch, gave way and was not persevered with in the lane. DRAMATIC SHOW close up outside a rival and had his heels clipped into the first turn, continued to stalk between foes, angled in and dropped back on the second turn, then also gave way and was not persevered with in the stretch. INDY FILM steadied hard when impeded at the spill into the first turn, then was pulled up into the backstretch but was walked off. NATIONALORE was close up outside a rival early but clipped heels entering the first turn and lost the rider, then was vanned off. The stewards conducted an inquiry but made no change when they ruled no blame could be assessed to any of the runners for the incident into the first turn.
