### Footnotes

PLASMA BEAM moved up on the inside to take the early lead, was headed in the lane and battled back on the inside in a game victory. THE WHAMMER moved up outside to press the early pace, took the lead in the stretch and was outfinished by his rival on the rail. GRAND CAPTAIN eased back between horses down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, angled out for the drive and rallied strongly to be a clear third. ALLABOUTTHECAPITAL was outrun down the backstretch, angled outside in the drive, but was no threat to the leaders. BARBARIC was away slowly, moved up outside on the turn, but had little left for the stretch run.
