Footnotes

DURING took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, turned back bids from EYE OF THE TIGER twice on the backstretch, fought back along the rail when headed into the stretch, regained the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. TEN MOST WANTED came off the rail on the first turn, launched a bid four wide leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, put a head in front three deep into the stretch and continued willingly through a stiff drive but was outgamed. EYE OF THE TIGER stalked the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid outside the winner twice on the backstretch, bid again between horses into the stretch and also continued on with good courage between foes to the wire. OUTTA HERE four wide early, stalked three deep then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, steadied off heels midway on that turn, angled out in upper stretch and came back on four wide on the line to share the show. BULLISTIC stalked off the rail then between horses, waited a bit between foes midway on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. LOGICIAN close up stalking the winner along the inside, dropped back some on the second turn and also weakened.
