SKY JACK had speed four wide then dueled outside MACANEO, inched away from that one on the backstretch, fought back inside MOMENTUM the rest of the way and held on gamely along the rail through a long, hard drive under left handed urging. MOMENTUM between horses early, took back approaching the first turn and stalked outside a rival, went up outside the winner on the backstretch, dueled alongside that one the rest of the way, reached even terms in the stretch but could not get by. MILWAUKEE BREW unhurried and angled in early, went around a rival early on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and rallied for third. DOLLAR BILL bumped at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came out on the backstretch, bid three deep, dropped back on the second turn, entered the stretch outside a foe and weakened. DIG FOR IT also bumped at the start, was close up between horses early then stalked off the rail, went between horses again on the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn and also weakened. MACANEO (ARG) had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the backstretch and gave way.
