Footnotes

EUCHRE three deep into the first turn, went up outside PEACH FLAT leaving that bend to force the pace, took a short lead into the stretch, fought off the bid of RIVER KEEN in midstretch and inched away under urging. SULTRY SUBSTITUTE in tight and steadied off heels into the first turn, continued toward the inside, pulled his way between foes leaving the backstretch, went around the pacesetter in upper stretch and finished well inside. RIVER KEEN (IRE) stumbled at the start, settled outside rivals, advanced four wide nearing and on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, ranged up alongside the winner in midstretch but could not match the top pair while best of the rest. PRIME TIMBER in a bit tight off heels into the first turn, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back into the second turn, went around a rival past midstretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. CROWS (ARG) saved ground unhurried to the second turn, came out around a rival on that bend and was not a threat. PATIENCE GAME was well placed stalking the leaders three deep, continued three deep on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PEACH FLAT sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside the winner and weakened in the stretch.
