Footnotes

MOOSSA'S GIRL quickly sped to the front, set the pace off the rail, angled in some on the turn and proved best under urging. TOOMANYTOMORROWS a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out into the stretch and was second best. EDITOR'S PARTY chased outside on the backstretch, angled in off the rail on the turn and bested the others. GAMBLEWITHMYHEART hesitated then walked out of the gate in a slow start, settled off the rail and passed tiring rivals. SLEW TO SIREN bumped with the winner at the start, was sent along a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and weakened. CHANCY TOSS a bit crowded at the start, was sent between horses early then off the inside leaving the backstretch and also weakened. CLUB HOUSE close up stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch, drifted out some into the stretch and gave way.
