CONGAREE assumed command and set a leisurely pace outside the runner-up under a rating hold, inched away approaching the second turn, continued toward the inside and drew clear under a crack of the whip in midstretch and a steady hand ride. UNTIL SUNDOWN forced the pace inside the winner, stalked that one into the second turn, came out midway on that bend and held second. JAMAICAN RUM unhurried off the rail early, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at the place. TOP HIT stalked the pace outside, dropped back outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BAYOU THE MOON saved ground off the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and did not rally. HOOVERGETTHEKEYS was in a good striking position while saving ground, remained inside throughout and weakened.
