VALLEY FOG chased outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the pacesetter, gained the lead past the eighth pole and proved best under urging. THUNDER'S HEAT stalked the pace off the rail or outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and split foes at the wire for the place. TAPFORTEXAS settled outside rivals then angled in, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the show three wide on the line. LINCECUM pulled on the early lead off the rail, angled in some, battled outside a rival leaving the backstretch then inched away again into the turn, found the inside on the turn, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for a minor award late. WINDY PARK stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail leaving the backstretch then tracked the leader again on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WARRENS TWO TO ONE chased off the rail or outside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MOMENTUM TRANSFER broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then just off the rail, angled in on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
