Footnotes

ROYAL TERESA took the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, inched away in midstretch, responded when briefly headed in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging while brushing with the runner-up late. SWEET FRIPPERY three deep into the first turn, pressed the pace outside the winner, came back at that one past the eighth pole, put a head in front in deep stretch, was brushed nearing the wire and just missed. KISSING GIRL (ARG) stalked inside then outside a rival leaving the first turn and on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for third. DARLIN COREY angled in and settled off the pace inside, came off the rail on the second turn, split rivals in midstretch and just missed 3rd. NATIVE HEARTBEAT pulled her way between horses early then angled in on the first turn, stalked inside, waited a bit leaving the second turn but weakened. IT WAS MEANT TO BE (GB) was pulled up in the run to the first turn and vanned off. A claim of foul by the jockey of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in late stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the light contact between them.
