Footnotes

THE DADDY stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the runner-up between calls on the turn, went after that one again in the stretch and wore him down under left handed urging. WHEATON HALL sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, turned back the winner's bid a quarter mile out but could not deny that rival late. BANGLED SONG broke in a bit, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and bested the others. CODE AMOUR broke out and slowly, chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. RESIDENT AUTHORITY bumped and squeezed back at the start, settled a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and was not a factor. MONTANA RIDGE hesitated to be off slowly, ducked out in the early stages, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and failed to menace.
