Footnotes

SECRET HEIRESS had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch under urging and proved best. MIREYA DIAZ went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back into the turn, tracked the winner leaving the turn and in the stretch, remained inside and held the place. SHESKEY stalked between horses then three deep leaving the backstretch and outside a rival midway and leaving the turn and bested the others. WAIT 'N SEA close up stalking the pace between rivals then inside on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. AVRIL IN PARIS was in a good position tracking the leaders inside on the backstretch and into the turn, was shuffled back nearing midway on the turn, came out in the stretch and also weakened. BOOKDMYOCEANCRUISE dropped back outside then angled in off the rail leaving the backstretch, continued outside a rival nearing the stretch and did not rally. BUSTER'S HURRICANE also dropped back off the rail early, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. FIFTY K chased outside then three deep, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in and had little left for the drive.
