Footnotes

JUSTICE REIGNS chased off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch, bid three deep past midstretch, gained the lead under urging a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. AEROMON between foes early, chased off the rail then outside a rival, split horses into and on the turn, bid alongside a foe leaving the turn, took a short lead in the stretch, fought back between foes past midstretch then inside the winner and continued willingly. COOKIN EXPRESSO between horses early, was in tight five eighths out, stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn, dueled on a short lead, fought back in the stretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. OLYMPIC MAGIC broke in a bit, chased just off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GOLD SCHLEIGER had speed between foes then stalked off the rail, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SOUVENIR SUMMER hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, settled inside to the stretch and was not a threat. TRUCO had speed inside then dropped back nearing the half mile pole, came out on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. KOPRITI broke out a bit, chased outside

then off the rail, split horses leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. TUNASITY dropped back between horses early, settled a bit off the rail and failed to menace. FLEMINGSTOUCHOGOLD a bit slow into stride, settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn and did not rally. PASEO DE RAMON had speed inside then inched away off the rail, lugged out into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gave way. EL NAVIGANTE prompted the pace four wide then three deep, stalked outside leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and also gave way.
