TENACIOUS TINA quickly sped to the lead, set all the pace along the inside and held on gamely under a strong hand ride. MISSDEALORNODEAL close up stalking the winner throughout a bit off the rail and held second. CAN'T TOPPER stalked the pace three deep early then off the rail, continued outside the runner-up on the turn and three wide into the stretch and also went on willingly late to save the show. WARREN'S GOT GAME chased a bit off the fence then along the inside into and on the turn and in the stretch and was edged for third. PERFECT VINTAGE chased the pace between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in approaching the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TORREY CLIFFS settled inside then outside a rival on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. VICTORY DANCER dropped back outside then chased off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and lacked a further response.
