CENTRALINTELLIGENCE had speed four wide then dueled three deep, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear and drifted inward in the drive and proved best under some left handed urging and strong handling. WHIPSTOCK between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out for room into the stretch, split horses three deep in upper stretch and edged a rival for the place. PHANTOM LOVER chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and was edged for second. MOROCCAN SKY a half step slow into stride, angled in and saved ground, came out into the stretch and bested the others. TUXEDO BLUES bumped at the start, dueled between horses to the stretch and weakened. FRENZO went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on a short advantage on the turn and also weakened in the drive. SEAL ROCK hopped slightly at the start, settled three deep then off the rail, angled in nearing the turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. ELUSIVE JOURNEY broke in, bumped a rival and steadied at the start, settled off the pace outside a rival, came out in the stretch and was not a threat.
