Footnotes

CHARLIE AND CHRIS had speed between horses then stalked off the rail or between foes, was in tight into the turn, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside in midstretch, gained the lead and won clear under urging. BLAME THE JOCKEY chased off the rail then angled in, steadied between horses into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place late between foes. RIVER ECHO between horses early, stalked outside then four wide leaving the backstretch and into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and just got the show. CHIEF'S LAKE stalked the pace inside, was shuffled back into the turn, came out into the stretch, bid outside foes past midstretch and was outfinished. DON ELIAS M. (MEX) a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into and through the stretch and bested the others. CONCLAVE dueled between horses then a bit off the rail on the backstretch and inside on the turn, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened. FIRE GLOW had good early speed and dueled between horses, dropped back in the stretch and also weakened. STRAY CAT sent between horse early, stalked inside, steadied in tight into the turn to fall back and

weakened in the stretch. AMBASSY vied for command three deep between horses on the backstretch and three wide on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. FUTURE READINGS stalked between horses, steadied in tight off heels into the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. PEACOCK ALLIANCE had speed six wide then prompted the pace four wide, stalked on the turn and weakened in the drive.
