Footnotes

MISS BEV HILLS, angled in approaching the first turn and saved ground off the pace, moved up some into the stretch, came off the rail past midstretch and surged late under some urging to get up at the wire. LAC TAHOE took command early, set the pace along the inside, shook clear again in the stretch and was nailed at the line. BLOSSOM BOUND, settled a bit off the rail, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. BRIDE, four wide into the first turn, continued outside, was four wide into the stretch and had a mild late bid. PETTING SLEW, chased off the rail, went between rivals on the backstretch and three deep into the stretch and lacked the necessary late response. TREASURED REALITY, stalked the pace a bit off the rail and also lacked the needed late kick. BETRAYER, came off the rail early, went three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in outside the winner on the second turn, tried to split rivals in midstretch but steadied when in tight off heels and lacked a further response. R SEATTLE SUZIE, saved ground but was outrun.
