LUCKY PULPIT dueled outside a rival on the backstretch, inched away on the turn, drifted out a bit late but held gamely under urging. GRAYDON GREY chased between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, angled inward in deep stretch and just got the place between foes. TRAIL MIX had good early speed and dueled inside the winner, stalked along the rail on the turn, came out in midstretch, lost second late and just held third three deep on the line. MINISTER ERIC off a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and was edged for the show. DINNER AT AGO'S stalked outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CURRITUCK wide early, settled outside on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in some leaving the bend and could not offer the necessary late kick. NATIVE APPROVAL off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and was not a threat. SANDYFORD also a bit slow to begin, settled outside, continued alongside a rival on the turn and failed to menace. TIZNUF stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and into the turn, continued between foes leaving the bend and weakened.
