BRIGHT DESIGN sped to the early lead off the rail, set a pressured pace between horses and held on gamely under urging. IT'Z ALL MINE stalked early then pressed the pace inside, fought back in the stretch and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner. TERESITA also stalked early then prompted the pace three deep most of the way and continued on well but settled for the show. PONTA DAS CANAS between horses early, chased off the rail then outside a rival, continued off the inside on the turn and could not summon the necessary late response. TRUE TO THE DREAM broke slowly, was taken off the inside early to chase the pace, dropped back on the turn and gave way. COPA DE ORO off a bit slowly, settled a bit out from the rail then along the inside, also dropped back on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and had nothing left.
