DIXIE UNION dueled outside SILVER ACE on the backstretch and between rivals on the turn, responded gamely along the inside in the stretch and inched away late under some left handed urging and steady handling. EXCHANGE RATE, prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch, dueled three across the track on the turn, took a short lead, lugged in a bit in midstretch and could not match the winner. HIGH YIELD, four wide early, angled in some on the turn, came four wide into the stretch to loom a threat behind the top pair in midstretch but settled for the show. NO CURFEW, veered out at the start and raced wide early, angled to the rail on the backstretch and saved ground on the turn, came out in upper stretch and did not rally. SILVER ACE sped to a slim early lead and dueled inside, dropped back into the stretch, drifted out some in midstretch and weakened.
