STAKES Swaps S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Late nominations of \$3,000 may be made on or before Sunday, June 13, 1999. A supplementary nomination of \$15,000 may be made at the time of entry. All horses (including supplements) to pay \$2,500 to pass the entry box, and \$2,500 additional to start, with a gross purse of \$500,000, of which \$300,000 to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth, and \$10,000 to fifth. Weight 124 lbs. Winners of \$250,000 at a mile or over three times in 1999, 2 lbs additional. Non-winners of two such races in 1999 allowed 2 lbs. Such a race in 1999 4 lbs. Such a race of \$100,000 in 1998-99 allowed 6 lbs. Such a race of \$50,000 in 1998-99 allowed 8 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden or claiming allowed 10 lbs, two such races allowed 12 lbs.

CAT THIEF sprinted up to the front and angled in early, duelled outside DESERT HERO and between rivals into the second turn, inched away from that one and angled in on that bend, then responded very gamely along the rail when briefly headed in the stretch and proved narrowly best under left handed urging. GENERAL CHALLENGE, pulled a bit when in off the winner's heels in the run to the first turn, settled outside WALK THAT WALK and stalked the pace, bid three deep into the second turn, put a head in front outside the winner in midstretch and continued gamely to the wire to just miss. WALK THAT WALK, saved ground in a good striking position, went around DESERT HERO into the stretch and lacked a further response. DESERT HERO, pulled under a hold along the inside early, duelled inside the winner for a bit more than six furlongs, dropped back on the second turn and had nothing left in the stretch.
