Footnotes

SMASH stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead under energetic handling past the eighth pole and won clear. DOUGHBOY sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, then could not match strides with that one while clearly second best. DEVOUR chased off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and got up for the show. DESERT PARADISE broke a bit slowly, chased between horses then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. CODE BUSTER hopped in a slow start, settled inside, split horses in deep stretch and was not a threat. MCKENZIES WAY broke a bit slowly, chased three deep then off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the turn and did not rally. FUTURE READINGS stalked between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, split rivals again on the turn and weakened in the stretch. THUNDER OF ZION had speed and inside and saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and also weakened. NITRO POWER broke out and a bit slowly, drifted out on the backstretch and was pulled up into the turn but walked off.
