THE BAT SIGNAL broke in a bit, stalked inside, came out in upper stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch to gain the lead and held on gamely under urging while drifting out some. SCOFIELD BARRACKS chased off the rail, went four wide into and on the turn and five wide into the stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. SYNCOBEAT bobbled slightly at the start, sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail then inside, inched away briefly into the stretch, fought back along the fence in midstretch, could not match the top pair but held third. WYLIE N WYATT a bit slow into stride, stalked between horses, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. J P JAMMER prompted the pace outside then three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. CEE'S CLOSING TIME bobbled a bit at the start, pulled his way along to force the pace between horses to the stretch and also weakened.
