Footnotes

MARLANG took the early lead outside a rival, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, responded when rivals loomed leaving the final turn and in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. CHAMP PEGASUS chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch to loom a threat behind the winner in midstretch but could not catch that one in the final furlong. UNUSUAL SUSPECT four wide early, angled in on the first turn then chased off the rail on the backstretch, found the fence on the final turn again, continued inside in the stretch and picked up the show. DYNAMIC RANGE chased inside then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) between horses early, settled outside a rival then angled in through the stretch the first time, came out leaving the backstretch and into the last turn, entered the stretch four wide and lacked the needed rally. GREAT SIEGE (IRE) stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the final turn, continued outside the runner-up leaving that turn, angled out into the stretch and weakened.
