TOTAL ADVANTAGE quickly sped to the lead and angled in, set all the pace inside and won clear under a couple swats of the whip and a strong hand ride while drifting out late. MANHATTAN EXPRESS stalked along the inside, came out into the stretch and was clearly second best. GOHALO chased between horses or off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. MISTER SLIPPERY stalked the winner outside a rival on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. CORKAGE FEE chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch,lugged out into the turn, continued between horses on the bend and lacked a further response. BUCKLAND MANOR broke inward and slowly, saved ground chasing the pace and failed to menace. CANNON ONE broke slowly and awkwardly, angled in on the backstretch, continued along the rail on the turn and was not a threat. SOFT LIKA ROCK settled off the rail, split horses into the turn, continued outside a rival and was never a factor. IVORY DANSEUR chased outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
