Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$300,000 at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 twice at a mile or over 4 lbs. Such a race of \$90,000 allowed 6 lbs. Non-winners of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over allowed 8 lbs. One such race allowed 10 lbs.

Footnotes

KUMARI CONTINENT stalked the pace outside a rival or off the rail, bid outside CASH RUN into the second turn and three deep into the stretch, then wore down QUEENIE BELLE under some urging and steady handling late. QUEENIE BELLE stalked the leader along the inside to the stretch, bid inside, took a short lead past midstretch but could not hold off the winner. SAUDI POETRY pulled her way into a bit of a tight spot off heels into the first turn and came off the rail, went up between horses on the backstretch and second turn, awaited room off heels into the stretch and in upper stretch, swung out in midstretch and continued willingly but could not catch the top pair. CASH RUN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled inside the winner on the second turn and between horses in the stretch but weakened late. KENTUCKY STORM forced out into the first turn, stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued off the inside leaving that bend and a bit wider into the stretch and weakened.
