### Footnotes

SULAYMONDO lunged a bit at the start, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch, then gamely wore down the leader under some urging. THE DR. IS A LADY stalked the leaders outside a rival, bid three deep on the turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear, fought back inside the winner and continued gamely to the wire. TIZZIFIED unhurried off the rail early, came wide into the stretch and bested the others. VOTE GETTER bobbled at the start, angled in and dueled inside, inched away briefly on the turn, battled inside the winner into the stretch, then weakened. WALL STREET RALLY saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and also weakened. OUR LADY T dueled outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back slightly midway on the turn and steadily weakened.
