BRIECAT pulled her way along outside to the early lead, inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held under some urging. WINE AND DYNE chased off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and closed willingly late. KELADORA four wide into the first turn, chased outside then three deep into and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. ECLATANTE had speed inside then stalked along the rail, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and weakened. DOUBLE DIP stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. STREET MATCH settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, angled back to the fence in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. HONNETE stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the drive. FILM EDITOR angled in and settled off the pace inside, saved ground, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
