Footnotes

CHARLOTTE FOREVER unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and wore down the runner-up under urging. WHY KNOTT ME TOO forced the pace outside a rival then stalked three deep into the turn, re-bid three wide into the stretch, gained the advantage outside a foe past midstretch, was worn down late, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. FIVE RIVERS sped to the early lead and dueled inside a rival but off the rail, kicked clear into the turn, fought back in midstretch and weakened late but held third. THRILL AFTER DARK stalked between foes and was in tight on the backstretch, continued between rivals on the turn, angled in entering the stretch, came out in midstretch and weakened. REATTA PASS saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and also weakened. LITTLE BIT WESTERN had speed outside foes then stalked three deep and weakened in the stretch. DA SVEDONYA stumbled at the start and lost the rider.
