**Footnotes**

BELLESKI angled in and stalked the pace outside a rival, waited a bit off heels leaving the second turn, cut the corner into the stretch, surged to a short lead between horses in midstretch and pulled clear under left handed urging. QUERO QUERO three deep into the first turn, settled off the rail, went three wide leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and just got the place. BETTY'S WISH close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid three deep between foes in midstretch, drifted in late and just held third. ACAGO pulled her way along four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside rivals in midstretch and just missed a minor award. VOZ DE COLEGIALA (CHI) chased between horses or outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. CHASETHEGOLD stalked the leader off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. FUDGE FATALE took the early lead and set the pace inside, inched away on the second turn, fought back in midstretch but weakened late. NOTTING HILL (BRZ) stalked outside, dropped back three deep into the stretch and also weakened. DAISYAGO in tight and steadied off heels into the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, came out late and did not rally.
