MUSIC'S STORM angled in and chased inside, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, advanced three deep into the second turn, bid four wide leaving that bend, battled outside the runner-up through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed under urging. GOLDEN ARROW also angled in and stalked inside, came out approaching the second turn, bid three deep between horses a quarter mile out, fought back inside the winner through a hard drive and continued gamely to the wire. RUSHIN' TO ALTAR off a bit slowly, settled off the pace toward the inside, moved up on the second turn, came out in the stretch and picked up the show. VRONSKY prompted the pace outside a rival, put a head in front between calls on the backstretch, battled between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. ASONG FOR BILLY four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and four wide again into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SUNKOSI angled in and dueled along the inside, fought gamely on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. AZILLION (IRE) saved ground chasing the leaders, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. TRUE PHENOMENON between horses early, chased outside a rival then off the rail, lugged out on the second turn and was not a threat. KIFISSOS (GB) rank between rivals chasing the pace, steadied in tight early on the second turn and weakened.
