Footnotes

COURTSIDE ACTION dueled between horses then four wide leaving the backstretch and into the turn, took the lead on the bend, inched away and angled in nearing the stretch, found the fence in the stretch and won clear under urging. BATTLE SCHOOL stalked between horses then outside, went three deep on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and was clearly second best. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) chased between rivals then off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and held third. TRUENO in tight between horses early, settled off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and was outfinished for the show. ZILARATOR went up inside to stalk the pace, was in tight off heels into the turn, came out on the bend and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GOOD TO GO prompted the pace five wide then stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and weakened. FRANCONI dueled three wide between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, stalked between horses on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and also weakened. WARRENS WILD THING pulled a bit then settled off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. PHILLY SLEW allowed to settle out from the inside, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SPINCO BOB broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, swung out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. SWONGS also a bit slow to begin, settled off the pace inside, also came out into the stretch and was not a factor. LEWDAGW N PARADISE dueled between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. JEFFREY'S GROOVE wide early, settled well off the rail, angled in on the turn and never menaced. WARREN'S BIG GOLD had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, dropped back, steadied slightly when rivals went past leaving the turn and gave way.
