Footnotes

WAR PILOT chased a bit off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, split rivals on the second turn, bid alongside a foe, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear and proved best under a brisk hand ride until the final strides. INCLUDING WARDO settled inside then just off the rail, split horses three deep on the second turn, continued three wide into the stretch, could not catch the winner but clearly bested the others. PARABLE broke out and a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the backstretch, went around a rival into the stretch, angled out in the drive and just got the show. GOT MILCH settled off the rail then outside a rival, continued inside on the backstretch, split horses on the second turn and was edged late for third. PALIO PRINCE four wide early and three deep into the first turn, tugged his way along to duel outside a rival, inched away briefly past midway on the second turn, fought back into the stretch, then weakened. RENEWING between horses early, stalked the pace inside, steadied and was shuffled back off heels leaving the second turn, went around a rival into the stretch and lacked a further response. BRYAN DANIEL had speed between foes then toward the inside into the first turn, stalked off the rail, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. COVERT REWARD hopped slightly at the start, pulled between foes then angled in on the first turn and dueled inside, dropped back leaving the second turn and gave way.
