MIZZEN MAST stalked the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, bid alongside the leader into the stretch, gained command in upper stretch and pulled clear under some urging while drifting out. MOMENTUM pulled a bit early, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and wore down the pacesetter for second. LOOKN EAST sped to the early lead outside the winner, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled inside into the stretch, could not match the winner and lost the place late. LEARNING AT KATHY between horses early, settled off the rail chasing the leader, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SIGFRETO three deep into the first turn, settled off the rail, came three wide again leaving the second turn and into the stretch and also could not summon the necessary late response. MAGIC HORN (FR) allowed to settle outside a rival, angled in on the second turn and failed to menace.
