**Footnotes**

HICKORY PETE forced the pace four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, gained the lead in the stretch and pulled clear late under some urging. IT'S A PERFECT DAY dueled three deep on the backstretch and between foes on the turn and until past midstretch, could not match the winner but held second. PLEASURE HONOR dropped back off the rail then angled in some, split rivals leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and finished well but was edged for the place. MY ONOMATOPOEIA went up inside to duel for command, fought back on the turn and until past midstretch, weakened some late and was edged for third. AT A BOY HARRY prompted the pace five wide then stalked off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and weakened. AFTERNOON IN RIO six wide early, forced the pace five wide on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, dropped back off the rail and also weakened. RACE FOR GLORY vied for command between horses, dropped back a bit off the rail into the turn and gave way.
