RAIL TRIP sped to a clear early lead, responded when rivals loom a half mile out to kick clear again, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and in the stretch, was mildly hand ridden in midstretch and proved best under a long hold. HIYA SILVER stalked outside then bid outside foes leaving the backstretch, tracked three deep on the turn, angled in some entering the stretch and was second best. WITNESS PROTECTION broke in a bit, stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and held third. AITCHO broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, also came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. JAKEY BOY stalked outside a rival then bid between foes a half mile out, tracked the winner inside on the turn and weakened. UNBRIDLED PAPILLON off a bit slowly, chased inside, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked a rally. JUDGE KENT allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the turn and failed to menace. TEMPTING CHARM stalked the early pace then bid between horses a half mile out, tracked the winner between foes again on the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and gave way.
