MAY DAY ROSE had speed between foes then angled in and set the pace inside, inched clear on the second turn and drew off under urging. TRUE WAY OF GRACE unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail on the first turn, moved up on the second turn, came out in the stretch then angled in and edged a rival late for the place. BIG TIZ pulled her way along inside and steadied into the first turn, stalked the winner off the rail to the stretch, continued inside in the final furlong and held third. DARLING CIANA angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, went around a rival leaving that turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for the show. WALLSTREETER angled in and pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, dropped back into the stretch and gave way. TEDDY'S PROMISE also pulled early when three deep then stalked outside a rival, also dropped back into and through the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
