BEND settled outside a rival, moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to get up on the wire. GHURRA pulled her way along to stalk the pace off the rail early, bid three deep between horses then outside a rival into the second turn, gained the lead, inched clear and held on well but was caught on the line. MAKE MINE MINNIE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and into the second turn and held third. MISSATACAMA (IRE) saved ground off the pace, was in a bit tight into the stretch and bested the others. NIQUITA (BRZ) chased just off the rail, also was in a bit tight split rivals into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. QUEMAR (NZ) pulled her way along inside stalking the pace, went between foes on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. HOTESSE (CHI) pulled hard off the rail early and had the saddle slip into the backstretch, moved up four wide, dropped back outside on the second turn and weakened. POSTERGADA (ARG) stalked the pace off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch, also dropped back on the second turn and weakened.
