CANDY PULL stalked the pace off the rail then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up late. POCOSIN'S GAME BOY had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, regained the advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch but was caught late. PREMIUM QUALITY settled outside chasing the pace, continued off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and picked up the show. MT. ORIENT dueled inside, put a head in front on the turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BASILE PREMIER a bit slow to begin and slightly crowded at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out in late stretch and was not a threat. MISTER FIPS (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. FACCHETTI close up tracking the dueling leaders between horses, dropped back between foes in midstretch and also weakened.
