GENTLE GIANT sped between horses to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and dueled inside, kicked clear into the stretch and drew off under some urging and steady handling. POHAVE three deep into the first turn, prompted the pace outside the winner, was no match for that one in the stretch but held second while drifting out late. SAUCY CAT lagged back a bit off the rail, moved some inside on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and picked up the show. DOMINGO JUAN (ARG) broke slowly, saved ground without early speed, remained inside and was outrun. STRIKING SONG broke inward, pulled his way to stalk the pace inside, dropped back a bit off the rail on the second turn and gave way.
