Footnotes

DE CAR GUY stalked the pace inside, waited a bit leaving the turn, came out, took the lead alongside a rival into the stretch, kicked clear and held under urging. DIRTY DISH MITCH squeezed at the start, settled off the rail, moved up outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted inward but finished well. CLEAR THE HALL broke inward and slowly to fall well behind, settled off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show. SKYSPY chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, angled inward into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BEAN WHO chased a bit off the rail then inside, remained inside in the stretch and was not a threat. TRAIL BLAZER allowed to settle outside a rival then a bit off the rail and could not offer the necessary late kick. TOPPLER stalked outside a rival then bid between horses and duelled for the lead, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. CAVANAUGH stalked the pace three deep then between horses on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. CAPITAN

SOLIS angled in and stalked just off the inside, bid along the rail on the backstretch, dueled inside and had little left for the stretch. SIMULCAST sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled three deep, fell back leaving the turn and weakened.
