Footnotes

DOMONATION settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out under some left handed urging in upper stretch, rallied under strong handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. MERITRICIOUS stalked outside, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch, came back on between horses in deep stretch but could not match the winner. TALES OF TIGGER was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail, bid three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch, also was coming back between rivals in the drive and edged the pacesetter for third. CRAGMONT had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, inched away in midstretch, could not match the winner in the late stages and was outfinished for a minor award. QUILLOTANO settled off the rail, angled in outside a rival leaving the turn and lacked the needed rally. CHARLIE'SBOYWINS between horses early, settled off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn and did not rally. HURRICANE HARBOR dueled outside a rival then between horses on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. NICE MOVE broke a bit awkwardly and slowly, settled just off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
