MUSICAL ARTS pulled her way along inside stalking the pace and was in a bit tight into the turn, came a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead just past the sixteenth pole and won clear. SUDDEN GHOST sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, held on well to deep stretch, could not match the winner late but saved the place while drifting in late. SCREAM QUEEN stalked three deep then outside the winner, came out a bit in the stretch and was edged for second. CAVALLETTA chased inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. A RACING DELIGHT chased three deep, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BULL RUSH settled outside chasing the pace, continued alongside a rival on the turn and did not rally. CAL BAYERS stalked a bit off the rail then between horses, angled to the inside on the turn and weakened. ANNALILI dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. HARD TO KNOW chased between horses, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
