CAYAMBE angled in and dueled inside, gained the lead on the turn, inched away in midstretch and won clear under some urging. CHIEF TEDDYBEAR chased inside, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for second. PICK VIC saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for second. ON OVERDRIVE chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GREGORIAN BAY saved ground throughout and improved position in the stretch. SPOT THE DIPLOMAT had speed outside then dueled alongside the winner to the stretch and weakened. LEGENDARY MUD stalked between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and also weakened. ROOSEVELT unhurried outside then off the rail, dropped back some on the turn and did not rally. TURQUOISE N GOLD stalked outside then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
