JOKER FACE saved ground stalking the pace, came out in midstretch and rallied under a strong hand ride to get up in the final stride. WELCOME HOME RYAN sent to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn, inched clear in the stretch and held on well but was nailed on the line. EVERY EGO five wide early, angled in before the first turn and chased a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out nearing midstretch and finished willingly. KING COLA stalked between horses, bid alongside the runner-up into and on the second turn, fell back some in the stretch and weakened. BRONSTER bobbled sharply at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ORBACH close up stalking the pace between horses and weakened in the drive. NAHEM was in a good position tracking the leader four wide then three deep on the second turn, drifted inward in the drive and had little left in the lane.
