Footnotes

CHIPS ARE DOWN between horses early, was brushed and in a bit tight into the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, angled in a bit entering the stretch, kicked clear, drifted in and held under left handed urging. YES HE'S A PISTOL four wide early, went three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but continued willingly to the wire. BECRUX (ITY) a bit washy at the gate, bobbled slightly at the start, was brushed into the first turn, dueled inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch but held third. TAKE A CHANCE between horses early, came in a bit and clipped heels into the first turn, settled just off the inside, found the fence on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. Claims of foul by the rider and trainer of TAKE A CHANCE against the winner for alleged interference into the first turn were not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the former was the cause of his own trouble. A claim of foul by the rider of BECRUX against YES HE'S A PISTOL for alleged interference at the same spot also was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
