Footnotes

WILD FLEECE stalked between horses, angled in on the second turn, took the lead along the rail nearing midstretch and won clear under urging. SWEET OCTOBER stalked three deep then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and outfinished a rival for the place. KAMI D B C had speed outside foes early, angled in on the first turn and set the pace a bit off the rail, was between horses in upper stretch and bested the others. FEEL FREE TO FLEE rank between horses early, chased inside then came out on the backstretch, continued three deep on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and weakened. QUIET ADVICE close up stalking the pace inside, steadied in tight inside the winner early on the second turn and also weakened. THIS IS MY SONG three deep into the first turn, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and did not rally. KAZANA between foes early, settled just off the inside and lacked a response in the stretch. DOMINGA broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace and was always outrun.
